Ungolan Pavilion



Glossary

Clarifying the intricacies of an APT Kimberley & Outback Wilderness Adventure.

a

Adaptors & Electricity

In the Kimberley, our wilderness lodges generate their own power. Each lodge can assist in charging items such as phones and cameras in central dining areas. CPAP machines can be accommodated when advised at time of booking.

On board your cruise, the voltage is 200V AC (European standard) and 110V AC (North American standard). Limited number of adaptors are available on board, or you are welcome to bring your own. For safety reasons, hair irons and clothes irons cannot be used in staterooms. Hairdryers are provided in each stateroom.

b

Beverages

A selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are included at your discretion on board throughout the day. Most lodges and hotels in the Kimberley are licensed to sell alcohol. They stock a limited range of alcoholic beverages for purchase, allowing you to enjoy an evening drink. Guests cannot bring their own alcohol. Alcohol is not permitted in some areas visited.

C

Clothing

The dress code on our cruises and tours is relaxed. When packing, consider the time of year you are travelling and that it can potentially be quite cool at night, particularly on inland tours. We recommend layering your clothing so that you can be prepared for changes in weather conditions throughout the day. Sturdy footwear is essential, and wet shoes are highly recommended on some tours.

For your cruise, light, comfortable clothing is ideal for during the day, but smart casual clothing for evenings on board the ship is recommended. You may wish to bring something a little dressier for the Captain's Dinners and cocktail evenings, however there will be no black tie or formal evenings.

It is essential you bring shoes that can get wet (e.g. reef shoes or rubber sandals), and are comfortable for walking in, for wet landings on shore. Flip flops or thongs are not appropriate. Your luggage should include a breathable windproof/waterproof jacket, hat with brim and walking trousers/shorts.

Currency

Australian dollars (AUD) are used on all 4WD land adventures. Euro (EUR) is the currency on board our expedition ships. Settlement of shipboard accounts are accepted with Visa, MasterCard and American Express.



Dining

At our Kimberley wilderness lodges, enjoy breakfast with hot and cold options, grab a packed lunch before you head out for the day, then savour a chef-prepared three-course dinner each evening.

All meals are included on board your cruise, including morning and afternoon tea.

Should you have any special dietary requirements, you must advise these at the time of booking.



Expedition Cruising

Expedition cruises are active and involve regular use of Zodiac vessels. These cruises feature a taste of exploration and adventure with an expedition team including naturalists, marine biologists, historians, geologists and photographers. A sense of adventure is required to take advantage of opportunities as they occur to enhance your cruise.

Health & Fitness

As Kimberley & Outback Wilderness Adventure tours visit remote areas and feature activities with varying degrees of difficulty, it is vital to select a tour with an activity level suited to your health and fitness. A good level of fitness is essential for you to undertake walks in hot conditions and over terrain with uneven and slippery surfaces. Some walks will require you to clamber over boulders up to one-metre high.

The nature of expedition cruising requires regular embarkation and disembarkation of Zodiacs for shore access, as well as wet landings on remote beaches, where footwear will get wet. Guests must be able to climb ramps and step in and out of smaller vessels. Walking frames are not permitted on any shore excursions.

It is your responsibility to carry any medication (which may require a cooler bag). Consult your local medical practitioner for any health advice.



Internet & Wi-fi

In the Kimberley and parts of the outback, mobile phone service is extremely limited. Wi-fi internet is usually available at all our Kimberley wilderness lodges and may also be available at other resorts/hotels at a cost but is not guaranteed. Wi-fi internet is included on board the ships, however it is limited and not guaranteed. Mobile coverage is not available during the cruise due to the remote locations.



Laundry

On 4WD land adventures, in-room hand-washing opportunities are available at each of our Kimberley wilderness lodges (however, washing is not encouraged at Bungle Bungle Wilderness Lodge due to water conservation principles). In larger centres hotels may feature coin-operated washing machines and dryers or they may offer laundry services (own expense). Our expedition ships have laundry services (own expense).

Luggage

As a general rule, airlines permit passengers in economy class to take one piece of luggage that does not exceed 160cm (63 inches) or weigh more than 20kg (44 pounds). We advise you to contact your airline carrier or travel agent for specific information prior to departure, as size and weight limitations may vary.

Each cruise guest is entitled to take one piece of luggage that does not exceed the above specifications.

On 4WD land adventures, due to the size of 4WD vehicles and strict regulations for vehicle weight, there is limited luggage capacity. Please pack your required items into one small bag (no hard suitcases) weighing no more than 16kg. Alternatively, suitcases are acceptable if they fit within the following dimensions of 66cm length x 35cm width x 32cm height. Please enquire about our APT duffle bags. If you have excess luggage, please arrange for it to be stored at your hotel if returning to it post tour or organise for it to be forwarded to the tour's final destination (at own expense).

Passports & Visas

Cruise guests must have a valid passport with at least six months' validity from the return date. It is your responsibility to ensure these are obtained prior to departure. No visas are required for Australian and New Zealand passport holders.



Travel Insurance

Weather

May through to September are the best months to travel through the outback as it is mostly winter time in Australia, however, it is the dry season for the tropical regions of Cape York, Northern Territory and the Kimberley.

In South Australia and outback Queensland, the temperatures are more moderate in the winter time.

For our Western Australia coastal tours, the best time to travel is from the beginning of July through to October.

The Kimberley region can be divided into two seasons – a wet season and a dry season. The dry season (May to October) will be mild to warm during the day, but can be very cold at night. From June to August, the days are fine and warm with cold nights. Inland conditions at night can drop to below zero degrees Celsius. Rainfall is rare.



Zodiacs

Zodiacs are versatile, inflatable boats, which provide a unique platform for observing wildlife and enjoying landscapes from sea level, enabling you to get closer to the sights. They provide a fast and safe way of going ashore in remote locations and are invaluable for exploration.
