THE "PATH BETWEEN THE SEAS." Stretching from Colón to Panama City, the Panama Canal was built by 65,000 men over a 20-year period. The French began the massive project in 1881, but stopped work as the mortality rate of workers increased and engineering problems arose. The United States took over the project under Theodore Roosevelt. When completed in 1914, the canal was hailed as one of the world's great engineering feats. Forty-eight miles

long, it crosses the narrowest stretch of the Isthmus of Panama, cutting thousands of miles off shipping routes that once stretched all the way around Cape Horn at the tip of South America. Crossing this manmade wonder through the heart of Panama, your ship will be raised and lowered through enormous locks at each end and you will enjoy a scenic cruise on the manmade, 21-mile-long Gatun Lake.





COZUMEL'S MAYAN & TOLTEC PAST. Located off Mexico's Yucatán Peninsula, the island of Cozumel boasts a rich Mayan and colonial past. Explore the colourful streets of San Miguel or visit Mayan and Toltec ruins of San Gervasio to gain insight into the island's ancient beliefs and customs. View the scenic lighthouse at Punta Sur. Or join snorkellers at Cozumel Reefs National Marine Park, the second-largest coral reef system in the world.

COLOMBIA'S TREASURE. With its scenic setting on the Caribbean Sea and intact colonial city, Cartagena is a cultural treasure. Its extensive fortifications, the longest in South America, once kept marauding pirates at bay. Lining the many plazas, beautifully preserved buildings boast colourful balconies, a hint of the vibrancy you will witness throughout the city. Visit the church of San Pedro Claver, named for the patron saint of missionary work.





TROPICAL BEAUTY & HISTORY. The Hawaiian islands of Kauai and Oahu are home to crystal waterfalls and lush rainforests that beckon the adventurous to explore the likes of Waimea Canyon, the "Grand Canyon of the Pacific," and Mt. Wai'ale'ale, the wettest place on Earth. At historic Pearl Harbor, learn about the events of December 7, 1941 at the USS Arizona Memorial, which commemorates those who lost their lives on that fateful day.

world's most visually stunning and romantic destinations, Tahiti is the cultural hub of French Polynesia. Its dramatic mountains skirted with swaying palms strike a breathtaking pose in shimmering Pacific waters. Immerse yourself in Papeete's continental flavour. Admire the Cathedral of Notre Dame and browse the vibrant market for shell necklaces, brightly coloured sarongs and the island's emblematic gardenia, the tiaré.



cultural capital of "oz". Celebrated for its magnificent natural harbour the world's largest, Sydney was founded as a penal colony in 1788. Since, it has grown from a colonial settlement into the major cultural centre of Australia. During an overnight stay, you will experience firsthand the allembracing welcome of Sydneysiders and one of the world's most free-spirited cities.

Admire the cultural jewel in Sydney's crown, the Sydney Opera House, the iconic UNESCO Site nestled harbourside like a gleaming white bird taking wing. Stroll the adjacent Royal Botanic Garden, one of the world's most important horticultural institutions. Explore The Rocks, a district named for the sandstone from which its original buildings were made. Today, its historic streets are complemented by craft shops and markets.





CRUISE INTO THE FUTURE. Experience a time-honoured travel milestone, celebrated by sailors as a rite of passage, marked by ceremony. The International Date Line is an imaginary line that passes from the North Pole to the South Pole and is used to designate the start of each day. Sailing west across this line in the Pacific Ocean means that you will effectively "cruise into the future," as you skip a day. Enjoy a toast on board to mark this momentous occasion.

AMAZING AUCKLAND. Boats dot the harbours of Auckland, the "City of Sails," proud home to America's Cup racing yachts. This maritime city is set on a narrow portion of New Zealand's North Island and surrounded by large harbours. Waitematā Harbour is the city's best-known body of water; the also sizeable Manukau Harbour lies on Auckland's opposite side. Geographically, each is nearly encircled by protective land, with only a narrow entrance from the sea.





A DAZZLING MARINE WONDERLAND. The world's largest coral reef system, Australia's Great Barrier Reef stretches some 133,000 square miles along the continent's northern coast. This magnificent natural structure, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, comprises about 2,900 individual reefs and 900 islands. During your call in Cairns, you may choose to venture out and witness its displays of vividly hued coral and abundant marine life up close.

KOMODO'S FAMED DENIZEN. Legend surrounds
Komodo's most famous resident. During your visit,
you will be on the lookout with a guide for the
island's namesake "dragon," Varanus komodoensis.
The largest lizard in the world, the Komodo dragon
can grow up to ten feet long and weigh as much as
150 pounds. The creature is protected within Komodo
National Park, often seen as a real-life Jurassic Park
for its unspoiled beauty and primitive inhabitants.



ANCIENT CITY OF BAGAN. Capital of the Kingdom of Bagan from the 9th to the 13th centuries, this prosperous city had more than 10,000 Buddhist temples and monasteries constructed on its nearby plains, drawing Buddhist pilgrims from as far away as India and Ceylon. The remains of some 2,200 of these comprise the Bagan Archaeological Zone. Highlights include Shwezigon Pagoda, Ananda Pagoda and the Tharabar Gate.

After explorer Marco Polo visited Bagan around 1275 AD, he wrote, "They make one of the finest sights in the world, exquisitely finished, splendid and costly. When illuminated by the sun they are especially brilliant and can be seen from a great distance." Bagan's golden age ended when Kublai Khan's forces invaded in 1287. For centuries the city was nearly deserted, but Burmese people returned during the British colonial period and have maintained the site ever since.





JAVA'S COLOSSAL MONUMENT TO BUDDHA.

Nestled amid Java's tropical landscape of mountains and volcanoes, Borobudur is the world's largest Buddhist monument. This magnificent pyramidal temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, towers at a great height. Pilgrims from all over the world walk up a clockwise path to the pinnacle, passing 2,672 reliefs and 504 Buddha statues along the way. You may choose to visit it, too, during your call at Semarang.


A BLEND OF CULTURE & COMMERCE. The bustling metropolis of Ho Chi Minh City seamlessly blends historic and contemporary elements to create its unique identity. French-style architecture from the colonial era can be seen throughout the city, including Notre Dame Cathedral's looming twin towers and Reunification Palace's stately facade, while its downtown area is a vibrant hub of modern commerce carried out beneath the gaze of 21st-century skyscrapers.





BUSTLING ISLAND NATION. Spread across 63 islands at the tip of the Malay Peninsula, Singapore is the world's only island city-state. The city was established in 1819 for the East India Company by Sir Stamford Raffles, after whom the famed hotel is named. Technology and economy are highly advanced here, yet the islands host plentiful parks. Your overnight stay allows you to take in its sophisticated wonders, including the stunning National Orchid Garden.

MUMBAI TREASURES. A blend of Indian traditions and Portuguese and British influences, Mumbai is bursting with colour and culture. A canvas of brilliant architecture, the enormous Gateway to India greets you at the harbour's edge. Even more vast in scope and ornate in design, Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus is a celebrated UNESCO Site, blending High Victorian Gothic and classical Indian palace styles. The city was home to India's most famous son, Mahatma Gandhi.



embracing the Holy see. The sovereign enclave of Vatican City, long nestled in the heart of Rome, houses some of the world's most transcendent masterpieces. You are sure to be astonished by St. Peter's Square, a vision in travertine and marble. Here, the Pope can address up to 80,000 followers. The square looks on the massive St. Peter's Basilica, the most celebrated building of the Renaissance.

For all its sweeping glory, the Vatican's details also send the spirit soaring. In the Vatican Museum, admire the Sistine Chapel's *The Last Judgment*, famously painted on the ceiling in lush strokes by Michelangelo. Browse the Gallery of Maps, depicting the cartography of Italy along a stunningly decorated 400-foot-long corridor. And mingle among the Gallery of Statues, a who's who of Hellenic and Roman deities and heroes.






A BEGUILING PINK CITY CARVED FROM STONE.

The ancient city of Petra dates to 1200 BC. After a colossal earthquake, the city was abandoned and lay undiscovered until 1812. During our call on Aqaba, Jordan, you may discover it, too. Of all Petra's haunting colossal remains, the iconic Treasury strikes the most dramatic profile with its two-story colonnaded facade. Sheltered from windblown sands at the end of a narrow gorge, it has been pristinely preserved.


HARMONIOUS GARDENS. A magnificent emblem of the Bahá'í faith, which embraces the spirituality of all things, the Hanging Gardens of Haifa slope down Mount Carmel. Its 19 terraces were inspired by elements of Persian, Nishat Bagh and English gardens. You can spend an entire afternoon strolling the lovely flower-lined pathways, marvelling at stunning views of Haifa and the Mediterranean, and admiring the symmetry of this perfect hillside garden.





ISLAND OF KNIGHTS. Millennia ago, visitors were welcomed to Rhodes by the Colossus of Rhodes, a towering statue of the sun god Helios. Today, travellers are greeted by another enormous landmark: the 14th-century Palace of the Grand Masters. A UNESCO Site, the medieval Knights of St. John of Jerusalem built the fortress upon conquering the island. A stroll down the heavily fortified Old Town's Street of the Knights leads you to this masterwork.

A STROLL INTO ANTIQUITY. One of the world's best-preserved cities, Ephesus offers an unparalleled look into the world of ancients. The colonnaded facade to the towering Library of Celsus is an awe-inspiring sight, as is the ancient amphitheatre which once held 25,000 spectators. Ephesus also holds an important place in Christianity. Here, St. John is said to have preached and Mary to have lived out her final days in a tiny stone house.



BARCELONA'S EASYGOING SPLENDOR. Kissed by Mediterranean breezes, Spain's Catalonian capital is a feast for the senses. Wide boulevards lined with stunning and whimsical architecture set the tone for a city that moves to its own tempo. Our overnight stay here gives you time to linger over small-plate tapas, a glass of bubbly cava and the magical buildings and parks of architect and favourite son Antoni Gaudí. Life slows down to a siesta pace

along Las Ramblas boulevard, the famed pedestrianonly thoroughfare lined with cafés and shops. Step into a tapas bar to partake in a long-cherished Spanish tradition, sampling small plates such as *calamares* and *croquetas*. You will quickly embrace this convivial style of dining, bursting with flavor and overflowing with the warm friendliness for which Spaniards are known.





INTOXICATING ISTANBUL. Istanbul exudes a heady mix of Western and exotic cultures. One of the city's most stunning centrepieces is Hagia Sophia. Founded as a basilica, during its history it has been a museum and an active mosque featuring exquisite mosaics and frescoes. For a taste of Turkish culture, visit the Grand Bazaar, the world's largest covered market. Wander among its selection of carpets and fabric, and sample luscious dates or the local favourite Turkish Delight.

NEOPOLITAN GASTRONOMY. Naples boasts a distinctive cuisine all its own. Seasonal produce features prominently, particularly such New World imports as peppers, beans, potatoes and tomatoes. Meat dishes often use sausage or pork liver. And classic Neopolitan desserts include *sfogliatelle* (a filled layered pastry) and pastiera cheesecake (made with ricotta and wheatberries). During your time here, be sure to sample these regional favourites.





THE RIVIERA'S GEM. The chic city of Monte Carlo in the petite kingdom of Monaco boasts some of the world's most exclusive shopping and a beautiful old port. Throughout this city and at the Prince's Palace, take in the fairy-tale setting of the late American-actress-turned-princess, Grace Kelly. Perhaps you will follow your nose to the legendary perfumeries of Grasse. As we stay late in port, there will be time to visit the prestigious Casino de Monte-Carlo.

A TILE'S TALE. Everywhere you look—from churches and palaces to train stations and park benches—Portugal is decorated with *azulejos*. Tinglazed ceramic tiles, *azulejos* are used on floors, walls and ceilings as both a decorative and functional element. Originating from Moorish traditions, tiles are arranged in geometric patterns. In the late 17th century, Delft influenced a change to the blue-and-white portrayal of scenes from Portuguese history and culture.

FOR MORE THAN 23 YEARS, Viking has had the highest standards of health and cleanliness, and our new, updated protocol enhancements make travelling with Viking even safer. Developed in coordination with an international team of scientific and medical advisors, the Viking Health & Safety Program is one of the most well-researched and comprehensive COVID-19 prevention and mitigation plans in the travel industry.

VIKING'S SAFETY-FIRST APPROACH:

PCR testing and dedicated PCR laboratories -

As the first cruise line to install a full-scale PCR laboratory at sea, Viking has now extended this to every one of its ocean vessels. This means we can conduct quick, non-invasive saliva PCR tests every day if necessary, testing crew and guests in the privacy of their staterooms and processing the results on board. Everyone will be tested prior to embarkation, and local partners – including motor coach drivers and tour guides – will be tested before any tours.

Improved air purification – All Viking ships now feature short-wavelength ultraviolet (UV-C) lights and new high-density filters that sanitise the air and kill 99.99% of all airborne bacteria and viruses. Plus, enjoy fresh air in your stateroom, knowing that all staterooms on Viking ocean ships feature independent air handling units that do not share air with other areas of the ship.

Health checks – All guests will complete a one-minute digital Health Questionnaire developed by scientific and medical advisors prior to travel, at embarkation and every day of their cruise itinerary. Temperatures will also be checked regularly using touchless thermometers and automated thermal cameras.

Physical distancing – When you take an ocean voyage with us, you can expect physical distancing measures to be in place in all public areas on board, during shore excursions and on board motor coaches, with face mask use in keeping with local guidelines.



Crowd-free check-in – To avoid a congested embarkation, you will be assigned a boarding time based on your flight arrival. Check-in counters on board will be spread out to ensure proper social distancing and will be sanitised between guests, with a touch-free online check-in option available. All cruise port terminals will also be sanitised prior to guest arrivals.

Industry-first sanitisation – In an industry-first, we are using new sanitisation robots that utilise UV-C light to treat surfaces in guest and crew public areas every night, while you're asleep. All surfaces on your ship and on motor coaches are continually disinfected, with daily deep cleanings scheduled and more hand sanitisation stations available.









Updated medical services – Each of our ocean vessels has always had a state-of-the-art Medical Centre, and now these have been upgraded with even more specialised equipment.

Safety from door to door – For guests with flights arranged by Viking Air, the strictest health and safety protocols are in place both in the air and on the ground, where there will be smaller group transfers to and from your ship, and safe distance between passenger seats.


